APPLICATION TO JOIN & EXHIBIT WITH IBBAS

As always, artists do need to familiarise themselves with the IBBAS Rules doc *which incorporates changes this year*, and can be downloaded from the APPLY page on our website. www.ibbas.co.uk

Because exciting changes have been made for 2019, in addition to reading the updated Rules, please note the following before making your application.

- IBBAS membership fee remains at £10.
- With a new venue and longer show, the exhibition fee has been increased to £20. Artists may now submit up to 5 hung pieces (as well as unframed and cards as per Rules doc). TOTAL fee payable therefore is £30.
- Titles etc are not required before July, but pieces submitted must have been made in the 12 months before the exhibition date, and with Inspired by Becker in mind (see 'Statement' next page).
- Artists are required to help with the running of the exhibition. (Details on page 3: 'Volunteering...').

To proceed with your application, please complete the information on pages 2&3 and post to IBBAS, Threeways, Coles Hill, Wenhaston, IP19 9DS by April 30th 2019.

- **Artist's Statement.** Please provide with this form, a maximum of 100 words in support of the work you plan to submit. This statement will be displayed alongside your hung work. It is important to describe what aspect(s) of Becker's work inspire you, and how these will be incorporated into your submissions.
- **Mike Holtom Award:** For artists wishing to be considered for the Award, this year's winner will be chosen from amongst entrants submitting a creative response to an original Becker work of their own choice. When you deliver your submission for the Award (on general delivery day), please also bring a clear reproduction of the chosen Becker original, presented neatly on A5 card, and a brief explanation of the working process of your Award piece, describing how you arrived at your response. The Becker reproduction and your working process will be displayed with your entry. ***These 2 items are required for judging.***

- **Volunteering help, including stewarding:** With an extended run in 2019 we are in urgent need of volunteers to **assist with the set-up and break-down as well as stewarding shifts during the event.** *Please tick below to show on which of the following dates and times you will be available to assist.*

Tuesday 20th August. (Morning). Set up day at Holy Trinity Church, Blythburgh. (involves lifting)

Wednesday 21st August. (Day and Evening) Volunteer to liaise with IBBAS team for planning and running the Private View. (Involves time before this date, and clear up after the PV).

Tuesday 27th August. (Morning). Break-down and clear up day at Holy Trinity Church, Blythburgh. (Some jobs include lifting).

Thursday 22nd through to Monday 26th August (morning or afternoon): Event Stewarding. *A minimum of one session is required.* If for any reason it is *impossible* for you to assist on any of these dates, **please contact us asap to discuss.** There are many tasks throughout the year, and there may be something you can help with.

Event stewarding sessions are either 10am until 1.30pm or 1.30 until 5pm. We need to cover a total of 20 stewarding sessions.
